Reenrollment Process Summary Page for Returning Students 2018-2019

Dear Returning Parents,

Thank you for your commitment to Catholic Education. In this packet, you have documents needed to be signed for reenrollment, except for your tuition contract. Please bring them signed to our Registration Day on Thursday, March 8th from 3pm to 7pm in the Cafetorium, whereby you will be able to pay your fees and sign your new contract.

Returning students having a signed contract and paid fees by March 8th will have the same tuition assistance available for 2018-19, however tuition will be \$6,400, a net increase of \$400 for each family so as to maintain quality teachers. In addition, the Registration Fee will also increase from \$180 to \$250, to offset the cost of electronic subscriptions necessary for instruction. Tuition assistance may not be available for returning students after March 8th. The reason for this deadline is for us to better plan on the number of teachers we will need next year, and determine the amount of assistance we have remaining for new students.

If you would like to pay your fees online prior to March 8th, please go to the Online Application on the Admissions page of website. Once the application is completed, you will click on "proceed to payment" in order to pay your Registration and PTO fee.

Please note:

- The tuition at St. JPIIHS does not fully cover the cost per student incurred by the school. The school makes up the substantial difference by annual fundraising activities by our families, grants, and its endowment.
- **Returning Students tuition assistance continuation deadline is March 8, 2018**
- Families that do not apply online can set up an appointment with the Registrar if they prefer to pay fees in the office or on registration day. Please print the PDF Application that can be found on the Admissions page of the website prior to appointment. Please call (361) 855-5744, ext. 202.
- The PTO fee (\$50) is the same as last year.
- There is a 10% reduction for each child if the family has more than one child at BGMPs or St. JPIIHS.
- PTO Fundraising Requirement
 - If your family receives **more than 25%** in tuition assistance, the requirement is \$575.
 - If your family receives **25% or less** in tuition assistance, your requirement is \$475
 - If your family **does not receive** tuition assistance, your requirement is \$400.
- Fundraising for individual teams and clubs at the school does not apply to a family's PTO fundraising requirement, however items donated to teams and clubs may apply toward their required 25 parent participation hours at a credit of \$10 an hour with receipt.
- Diocesan background check required when students turn 18 years' old
- Student drivers on campus need to fill out application, pay \$5 fee, and have DL & Insurance
